

USGA CHAMPIONSHIP BETTING POLICY

Overview

POLICY PURPOSE

Maintain the integrity of, and prevent **betting-related**¹ misconduct in, any USGA Championship

COVERED PERSONS UNDER THE POLICY (APPLIES TO ANY USGA CHAMPIONSHIP)

- Players
- Caddies
- Player Affiliates (e.g., family members, spouses, partners, agents, managers, instructors, and trainers)
- Marshals
- Officials
- Competition Personnel and Volunteers (e.g., walking scorers and standard bearers)

PROHIBITED CONDUCT FOR ALL COVERED PERSONS (APPLIES TO ANY USGA CHAMPIONSHIP)

Betting on the outcome or any other aspect of **Contriving** the outcome or any other aspect of a a USGA Championship **USGA** Championship Facilitating Unauthorized Third Party Access to × **Providing Inside Information** to another person any USGA Championship for the purpose of (e.g., not publicly available information relating conducting prohibited activity to any USGA Championship) **Failing to Give Best Efforts:** (1) Players cannot **Transmitting Data** (including through electronic accept money or other value to not give best devices) that a Covered Person knows or should efforts during a USGA Championship, and (2) have known is likely to be used for betting on a Covered Persons cannot encourage Players to fail **USGA** Championship to give best efforts × Soliciting, Encouraging, or Facilitating Betting × Associating with Betting-Related Persons or by Others Providing Betting Advice/Analysis/Tips to Others

OBLIGATION TO REPORT

Covered Persons are required to report any prohibited activity to the USGA.

¹ **Betting-related** is defined as placing any money or other thing of value on the occurrence or non-occurrence of a specific outcome with the expectation of receiving something of value in return.
